

QNUK LEVEL 2 AWARD IN VENUE SECURITY OPERATIONS (RQF)

This qualification is the main qualification within the Venue Safety & Security Suite, it combines the three smaller unit based qualifications into a single 'all-inclusive' qualification for those who specialise in working at public events.

This qualification is for learners who work in a front line role ensuring the safety of customers at public events, including a wide range of subjects from behaviour detection and analysis to the infrastructures required to support a safe and screened ingress to venues, incidents including forced access attempts, crowd surges, uncontrolled egress, social engineering and working with multi-agency approaches are covered from an operatives perspective.

This qualification is aimed at learners 18 years and over.

All learners must have completed the ACT Awareness and ACT Security e-learning prior to attending the course and provide the trainer with copies of the certificates.

It is recommended (but not essential) that learners hold a Level 2 (or higher) SIA or Spectator Safety qualification to help underpin the knowledge within this qualification.

ASSESSMENT

The method of assessment for this qualification is by a Multiple Choice Examination (MCQ)

As this qualification is regulated in England, the assessments are conducted in English. It is important that learners have reasonable abilities in English language to have a fair opportunity of being successful.

This is a 2-day Course
