QNUK LEVEL 2 AWARD IN RESPONDING TO SECURITY AND SAFETY INCIDENTS (RQF)

This qualification is one of the unitary qualifications within the Venue Safety & Security Suite, it provides the learner with the key knowledge required to respond to critical, terroristic, violent and crowd incidents alongside a multi-agency approach.

This accredited qualification is for learners who work in a front line role ensuring the safety of customers at public events, including a wide range of subjects from appropriate responses to a 'person of interest', clear and obvious threats, entry point compromise and crowd surges. The roles and responsibilities within a multi-agency response are also covered from an operatives perspective.

This qualification is aimed at learners 18 years and over.

All learners must have completed the ACT Awareness and ACT Security elearning prior to attending the course and provide the trainer with copies of the certificates.

It is recommended (but not essential) that learners hold a Level 2 (or higher) SIA or Spectator Safety qualification to help underpin the knowledge within this qualification.

ASSESSMENT

The method of assessment for this qualification is by a Multiple Choice Examination (MCQ)

As this qualification is regulated in England, the assessments are conducted in English. It is important that learners have reasonable abilities in English language to have a fair opportunity of being successful.
